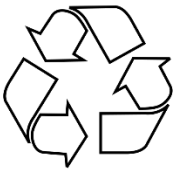

Hamburg Recycling Program

KEEP IT CLEAN –All recycling **MUST** be free of food and/or waste.

The 4th Tuesday of every month – Bottles, Cans and Containers

Rinse out all containers!

- **Glass Jars & Bottles - All Colors**
- **Plastic Containers #1 thru #7**
Check recycle mark on container for #. 
- **Tin, Steel & Aluminum Bakery & Beverage Container**
- **Cartons** - milk or juice cartons - plastic mixed with coated cardboard/paper

Must be placed in a reusable container.

Do not use plastic bags!

The 4th Wednesday of every month is paper/cardboard.

- **Newspapers, Magazines, Junk Mail** must be bound in one-foot stacks and cross tied or placed in reusable containers not to exceed 75 lbs.
- **Corrugated Cardboard** must be flattened and cross tied
- **Shredded paper** can be placed in a reusable, easy to empty container.

Do not use plastic bags!

DO NOT -

- Mix trash with Recyclables
- Put Recyclables out in plastic bags
- Put more than 75 lbs. in a single container
- Put out Styrofoam or Caps and Lids in recycling – they are garbage
- Mix together Co-mingled and paper recyclables

IF YOU DO YOUR RECYCLING WILL NOT BE PICKED UP!

- Recycling should be put out the night before pickup or by 5:00 A.M. the day of pick up.
- If recycling pick up falls on a Holiday have the recycling out by 3:00 A.M. the following day.
- In the event of inclement weather the day of pick up, recycling will be picked up the next business day.

Residents may deposit sorted recyclables free of charge at the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority (SCUMA) Recycling Center located on State Highway 94 in Lafayette Township. The SCUMA Facility is open Monday-Saturday (except holidays) from 7:00 am-2:00pm. For additional information on the SCUMA recycling center, please call 973-579-6998.

In collaboration with Hardyston Township, Hamburg residents may participate in Hardyston Can Program by purchasing solid waste and recyclable cans at resident rate. They can be purchased at the Hardyston Township Municipal Building at 149 Wheatsworth Road, 973-823-7020.
