It has been a long and very different summer due to the continuing presence of Covid-19 and I want to thank all our residents for doing their part to help limit the spread and prevent future outbreaks.


As of the date of this publication it looks like schools will be back in session, at least part time. Please be mindful of the increase in traffic, both on foot and by car. Drive carefully!

Hamburg School

We are happy to welcome back staff and students for in-person instruction beginning Thursday, September 3rd. The students will operate on a four

and a half hour schedule of classes. Lunches will be provided in "to-go bags" to enjoy after dismissal. Staff will remain at school to provide virtual instruction in the afternoon.

Like all New Jersey schools, Hamburg School is offering remote instruction for learners who choose not to access the school building. Brush and Leaf pickup will continue through November. All items must be placed curbside by 7 AM. We will make one trip through town. CURBSIDE PICKUP ONLY! Brush must be cut in lengths of no longer than 5 ft. Leaves must be placed in

biodegradable bags.

The following items will **NOT** be picked up:

- Plastic bags. They are not biodegradable!
- Bags that are too heavy.
- Bags that contain metal wire, plastic, rocks or concrete.
- Brush over 5 ft. in length.

If we do not pick up your leaves and brush a notice will be left explaining why.

If you cut down trees or have them taken down we will not be able to pick them up - this is a brush service only.

- Plan an escape route with your family in case of fire.


