The new meters require indoor installation and the homeowner or a responsible adult must be present to provide access to the home.

Pet Safety

For the safety of your pet and others please remember to keep your dog on a leash when not indoors or contained in a fenced in yard.

Per Ordinance 70-12 Section B. "No person owning, keeping or harboring any dog shall suffer or permit it to be upon the public or private streets or in any public place of the Borough of Hamburg unless such dog is accompanied by a person over the age of 12 years and is securely confined and controlled by an adequate leash not more than six feet long."

During the summer months the Road Department will be picking up **grass clippings only**. Pickups on Mondays and Fridays only. Please have the bags curbside by 7 A.M. We will only make one trip through town each day. Bags placed

curbside after the truck has passed will remain until the next pickup date. Do not put bags in the gutter or road. When it rains they break open and clog storm drains and lines. Bags found containing any rocks, dirt, dog waste or household garbage will not be picked up.

We also ask that all homeowners please refrain from blowing cut grass into public streets. It's important to keep the storm drains clear of debris.

As always if a storm comes through and tree limbs come down please drag curbside and we will pickup.
