

4. Marketplace Deli – on June 18th a water sample was done which showed contamination, a potable water tank was brought in and there were 5 samples taken on June 22nd which all came back satisfactory.
5. Taste of Italy – The business was able to open; they did receive a satisfactory with conditions from the County. One of the conditions was that they had 4 months to install the correct flooring and they were given 6 months to install a dishwasher.
