### 7) Old Business/New Business:

Farida's Hair Salon, LLC Block 22 Lot 31 LZ10-001

Applicant Attorney (William Mack) introduces himself to the board and gives a general overview of the application. The applicant would like to operate a hair salon at the property in question. He goes on to quote the zoning ordinance and asks for an interpretation from the board as to whether this use would be permitted in a highway commercial zone.

Board Attorney Glenn Kienz brings to everyone's attention to the zoning ordinance section 215-64 A. (1) and 216-66 B. both define retail stores and service establishments to include barbershops and beauty shops. He goes on to suggest to the board that even though the zone for highway commercial does not have clear definitions it is clearly defined in two (2) other sections of the ordinance. He does not feel there is any cause for a use variance.

Chairman Bob Adams states for the record that because the highway commercial zone does not have clear definitions the zoning officer was right to send the application to the board.

Board Attorney swears in the owner of the property Harry Bootsma

Harry Bootsma comments on Johns concerns.

Chairman Bob Adams asks Mr. Bootsma if at any given time all three (3) retail spaces have been occupied at the same time? He is wondering if parking is adequate when all three businesses are running.

Mr. Bootsma states that there is never any major stress on parking because most of the traffic is come and go and by appointment.

Rich Krasnomowitz states that according to the submitted floor plan it looks like there are a total of 8 chairs. Will there be 8 employees there at any given time?

Board Attorney swears in the business owner Jerel Belcher.

Mr. Belcher states that there are only 5 work stations and 3 dryer stations. There will be 3 employees to start.

Board Engineer asks about the shed that the owners have and if they received a zoning permit.

Mr. Bootsma states that they did receive an approved zoning permit.

Board Engineer recommends that they shed be mentioned in the resolution making it officially approved for future reference. He also questions the macadam that encroaches onto the neighboring property.

Mr. Bootsma states that this was preexisting when he purchased the property. He has his property line clearly marked. He goes onto to state that he moved the dumpsters onto the macadam on his property.

Discussion continues about the macadam, the neighboring property and the location of the dumpster.

Board Engineer asks that the owner get the survey changed to show the current location of the dumpster via an owner certification.

Board Planner Ken Neslon states that all of his concerns were covered by the Engineer.

Chairman Bob Adams asks the business owner what the hours of operation will be and if there is any additional lighting being installed.

Mr. Blecher states that the salon will be open Tuesday – Saturday from 8am – 8pm and there will be no additional lighting being installed.
