The date for Hamburg Day will be Sunday, September 9<sup>th</sup> from 12 noon to 4 pm. Paula received a price quote from Real Amusements- face painter/tattoo artist, bounce house, obstacle bounce house, fire truck ride, boxing ring, rock climbing wall, petting zoo/pony ride- a total of \$7240.00 which includes staff and generators to run all items. Discussion includes total price, music, balloon man, bubble man, food, and vendors. Members decide that the boxing ring is really not necessary and Paula will find out how the cost will differ if that is cut out. Kathy will contact Ray Sikora, Ed Miller, and Mark Ghia to see if they are interested in performing. The vendor application will stay the same with the fee being \$20.00, non-profits free of charge, and also clinics vendors free of charge. Kathy will make the necessary changes and post to the website.

## Summer Basketball League

Recreation received a request from Mr. Sharvez Brown asking for help in starting up a summer basketball league here in Hamburg, playing on the school outdoor basketball court.
