

HAMBURG RECREATION COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

April 17, 2018

OPEN MEETING / FLAG SALUTE

In accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, with regards to notices, the regularly scheduled meeting of the Hamburg Recreation Commission was called to order at 7:00 PM., April 17, 2018 with a flag salute.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion by Paula Marino, seconded by Sam Villagomez to approve the March 20, 2018 Regular Meeting Minutes. All members present in favor. Tara Scrittore abstained.

FINANCE

Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer's Report as prepared by Christine Licata showed a total of \$20,992.83 due to receiving budget money for the year.

Motion by Sam Villagomez, seconded by Paula Marino to accept the report as given. All board members present in favor.

OLD BUSINESS / NEW BUSINESS

Clinics

Councilman Fitzpatrick gave an update on the clinics: arts and crafts had 40 kids; speed training had 35 in attendance which ended the clinics for the year. Councilman Fitzpatrick asked if the board wanted the clinics to continue next year and after all agreed they did, he stated notices would go out in a few months for the 2018-2019 school year.

Easter with the Bunny

Joyce said the event was very successful as 22 registered but 68 people showed up. Someone ran out to buy more food, etc., but everything went well.

Sparta Bowling Lanes

Kathy re-did the flyer to include the cost of the event - \$7.50 per bowler which includes 2 games and shoes. The new flyer will be delivered to the school for distribution. Sam will be there on the day of the event to collect the money.

Family Fun Night

Chris, Sam, Paula, and Joyce all said they will be attending this event on April 21st at 5:45 pm – 7:45 pm. So far Chris has 50 plus registrations.

Ice Cream Social

Joyce will fill out the temporary food vendor application required by the Board of Health. Paula will contact Tom Gardner to negotiate his fee for the event. Flyers to pre-register will be sent out after 5/13. Vanilla and chocolate ice cream will be purchased along with sherbert. Toppings will also be included.

Miss Hamburg Contests – June 10th

The contests will be held on June 10th beginning at 1 pm at the Hamburg School, with members arriving at 12 noon for set up. Kathy will send out the applications to the high schools, Hamburg School, and pre-schools. Joyce will do the shopping.

2018 Miners Baseball – July 7th

Chris has a singer for the National Anthem. Joyce will ask Jennifer Brennan and Ricky Padgett to throw out the 1st pitch. A flyer will be sent to the school before June 21st for the kids to take home. The cost of the event is \$9.00.

Evening in the Park

Since Kathy has not been able to contact the NJ Musicians, Paula mentioned having another band play instead – Invited Guests – and they play all types of music. Members are fine with the change so Paula will check the dates of August 11th or 18th with the band. The cost of the band would be approximately the same as NJ Musicians \$500.00. More discussion to follow.

Hamburg Day – September 9th

The date for Hamburg Day will be Sunday, September 9th from 12 noon to 4 pm. Paula signed the agreement with Real Amusements- face painter, glitter tattoo artist, one petting zoo and 2 pony rides, fire engine trackless train with attendant, castle obstacle course, rock climbing wall, 4 attendants, generators for bounce houses for a total of \$6540.00.00. Paula also said Ray Sikora (music) was contracted for \$350.00; Ed Miller (bubbles) for \$230.00; Mark Ghia (balloons) for \$500.00. Keith Sukennikoff was concerned about the date as it is a week before the Firemen’s Convention and it is a busy time with getting ready for Wildwood and purchasing of the food items for Hamburg Day. Mike Schneider, Bill Oehler, and Ron Garrett all volunteered to help him. Joyce also will ask at the Auxiliary meeting for volunteers. Paula will check into a hot dog vendor and Tara will call about food vendor participation. Advertising will begin!

A donation request was received from the Sussex County YMCA for their 2018 fundraising campaign for kids to attend the facility.


