

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 197 - TOWING -
OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG
TO REGULATE THE NUMBER AUTHORIZED
TOWING COMPANIES IN THE BOROUGH OF
HAMBURG

Ordinance #08-2011

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg, in the County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 197- Towing - of the Code of the Borough of Hamburg is hereby amended as follows:

1. Add to Section 197-2 A:

The rotating list shall not contain more than four (4) towing companies; provided, however, that all towing companies on the rotation list at the date of passage of this ordinance may continue to provide services as long as they meet the criteria of this chapter.

2. Section 197-4 B (1) (a) {2} is amended as follows:

Each additional mile: \$4.00

3. Section 197-4 B (1) (b) {2} is hereby amended as follows:

Each additional mile: \$4.00

4. Section 197-4 B (2) is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

Storage Fees: \$35.00 per day

5. Section 197-10 (F) is amended to provide that the administrative fee shall be \$200.00 per year.

6. Any ordinance, or part thereof, inconsistent with the provisions herein is hereby repealed.

7. This ordinance is deemed severable, and in the event any part hereof is deemed or declared invalid for whatsoever reason by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

8. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
