

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 209 -
WATER - OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH
OF HAMBURG COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE
OF NEW JERSEY TO MODIFY WATER RATES**

Ordinance # 04-2020

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg, in the County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 209 - WATER - of the Code of the Borough of Hamburg, is amended as follows:

1. 209-6 C - Rates and Charges shall hereafter provide as follows:

RATES FOR METERED WATER


<u>Quantity Used</u>	<u>Charges Per Thousand Gallons</u>
Minimum charge per quarter up to 5,000 gallons.	\$ 34.65
5,001 gallons to 50,000 gallons per quarter.	\$ 34.65 plus \$3.19 per thousand gallons over 5,000 gallons.
50,0001 gallons to 100,000 gallons per quarter	\$ 178.51 plus \$2.77 per 1,000 gallons over 50,000 gallons.
100,001 gallons to 1,000,000 gallons	\$ 317.07 plus \$2.13 per 1,000 gallons Over 100,000 gallons.
Over 1,000,000 gallons.	\$ 2,231.49 plus \$1.70 per 1,000 gallons over 1,000,000 gallons.

2. This ordinance is deemed separable. If any part is declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the rest and remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
