BOROUGH OF HAMBURG ORDINANCE NO. 06-2020

CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PAVING AND IMPROVEMENTS TO MULBERRY ST. (Heritage lane to dead-end), HILLSIDE DRIVE, SUNRISE COURT, HIGH STREET, LONGVIEW DRIVE, CENTER STREET AND VARIOUS OTHER ROADS AS NEEDED BOROUGH BY THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$110,000 THEREFOR FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE BOROUGH AND \$135,000 FROM THE DOT **GRANT** FOR A **TOTAL** APPROPRIATION OF \$245,000 TO PAY FOR THE COST THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The improvement described in Section 2 of this capital ordinance is hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Borough of Hamburg, New Jersey as a general improvement. For the improvement or purpose described in Section 2, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$110,000 from the capital improvement fund of the Borough and \$135,000 from the DOT Grant.

Section 2. (a) The capital improvement hereby authorized and the purpose for the use of the capital improvement fund and DOT grant is for paving and improvements to MULBERRY STREET (Heritage lane to dead-end), HILLSIDE DRIVE, SUNRISE COURT, HIGH STREET, LONGVIEW DRIVE, CENTER STREET AND VARIOUS OTHER ROADS AS NEEDED IN THE BOROUGH necessary therefor or incidental thereto.

Section 3. The capital budget of the Borough of Hamburg is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended

capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after final adoption in accordance with applicable law.
