Brush and Leaf pickup will continue through November.

Brush must be cut in lengths of no longer than 5 ft. (pieces over 5 ft. will not be taken). Leaves must be placed in biodegradable bags. Plastic bags are not biodegradable and will not be picked up and bags that are too heavy will not be picked up. It is also very important that no metal wire, plastic, rocks or concrete are placed in the bags. If those items are found, the bags will not be picked up.

All items must be placed curbside by 7 AM. We will make one trip through town CURBSIDE PICKUP ONLY! If we do not pickup your leaves and brush a notice will be left explaining why.

If you cut down trees or have them taken down we will not be able to pick them up as this is a brush service only.

Biodegradable bags are available at the Borough Hall M-F from 8AM - 3 PM.

10 bag limit per Hamburg Resident.

Please honor the limit so we will have enough for everyone. Thank you.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RESPONSE TEAM VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Applications are being accepted for volunteers to join one of the regional Domestic Violence Response Teams (DVRT). These teams of trained community members respond to the police station immediately following an incident of domestic violence, assisting victims and their children by offering support, encouragement, information, and referrals. Volunteers work in partnership with law enforcement officers and domestic violence professionals. The application process includes submission of the application form, a personal interview, completion of a minimum 40-hour training course, and reference and criminal background checks. The next training will begin this fall. Interested persons should submit the application as soon as possible to begin the process. Applications are available by contacting DASI at info@dasi.org.

Hamburg School Awarded Toshiba Grant

Toshiba America Foundation awarded the Hamburg School a \$6,000 grant to replicate a canine prosthetic. The middle school students will partner with the canine's handler and a veterinarian to cast a mold, use a 3 dimensional scanner to digitize the mold, then print the prosthetic using a 3D printer. Students will journal and reflect throughout the process using a green screen broadcast system.

The Toshiba grant has allowed for the purchase of two 3D printers, a 3D scanner, and an Apple iPad studio setup to allow for the broadcasting. The students and staff are very excited to meet our canine partner and look forward to successfully developing a prosthetic.
