BEAR TROUBLE

The bears are back and the trouble has already started. They are drawn to the smell of garbage and have been causing a costly mess in both public and private neighborhoods. Please be aware that should your garbage become a nuisance you may be fined for the cost of the clean up. To help prevent these issues please:

- **Use bear-proof garbage containers**
Bear Resistant Cans are available for purchase through Hardyston Township at a cost of \$50 each.. More information may be found at: <http://www.hardyston.com/fees-applications/bear-resistant-trash-recycling-cans/>
- **Put garbage out the day of collection not the night before**
- Wash garbage containers with disinfectant solution at least once a week to remove odors
- Feed outside pets during daylight hours only. Immediately after feeding, remove all bowls
- Clean outdoor grills thoroughly after each use
- Do not place meat or sweet foods in compost pile
- Only feed birds Dec. 1st thru April 1st when bears are least active.

Summer is here and the road dept. will stop picking up brush on Wednesday, June 13th but will begin again in the fall. Throughout the summer we will only continue to pick up grass and leaves. Pick up will be done on Mondays and Fridays only. Please have the bags at curbside by

7:00 A.M. Remember: only properly bagged grass and leaves will be picked up. No rocks, dirt, dog waste or household garbage should be placed in the bags. If bags are too heavy or ripped open, they will not be picked up.

Thank you for keeping the road clear during street sweeping which has now been completed.

We ask that all homeowners please refrain from blowing cut grass into public streets. It's important to keep the storm drains clear of debris, especially cut grass which can cause serious clogs.
