Keep It Clean

The SCMUA has dedicated operations staff and resources, to maintain clean recycling streams at the Solid Waste/Recycling Facility and all regulations regarding recycling are now being strictly enforced.

All recycling MUST be free of food and/or waste.

DO NOT -

- Mix trash with Recyclables
- Put Recyclables out in plastic bags
- Put more than 75 lbs. in a single container
- Put out Styrofoam or Caps and Lids in recycling – they are garbage
- Mix together Co-mingled and paper recyclables

Brush and Leaf pickup will continue through November. Brush must be cut in lengths of no longer than 5 ft. (pieces over 5 ft. will not be taken). Leaves must be placed in biodegradable bags. Plastic bags are not biodegradable and will not be picked up and bags that are too heavy will not be picked up. It is also very important that no metal wire, plastic, rocks or concrete are placed in the bags. If those items are found, the bags will not be picked up.

All items must be placed curbside by 7 AM. We will make one trip through town CURBSIDE PICKUP ONLY! If we do not pickup your leaves and brush a notice will be left explaining why.

If you cut down trees or have them taken down we will not be able to pick them up as this is a brush service only.

Biodegradable bags are available at the Borough Hall M-F from 8AM - 3 PM.

10 bag limit per Hamburg Resident.

Please honor the limit so we will have enough for everyone. Thank you.
