Application LU 10-005 Amazing Stoneworks

Packets include: application, maps, professional reports and all relevant correspondence

Attorney Keinz states that this application may be a use variance based on the recent submission from the applicants' attorney. He then asks the planner Ken Nelson to review his findings.

Nelson gives a brief history of the prior property uses and what the current zone (light industrial) covers. His main question is what category this application fits under within the light industrial use. He feels that this application falls more under the retail category than industrial.

Applicant attorney Zimmermann states that his clients strongly feel this application does not fall under the use of retail. It is mainly a dealer showroom. It is not something the public is invited to see. Most of it will be appointment based only. The materials will not be stored onsite. The jewelry component will also be wholesale only.

Kienz asks Nelson in his professional opinion, given what attorney Zimmermann just stated, what use would this fall under.

Nelson after hearing what the Attorney Zimmermann has stated it really is a unique use and he does not know what it falls under. He would categorize this as a technical "d" variance.

Nelson states that he does have some site plan concerns. He recommends that before the next meeting that John Ruschke and himself meet with the applicant to review them.

Chairman Adams references the letter from James Zimmermann October 1, 2010 section 2 item A. He asks Nelson if this could fall under light industrial use.

Nelson, no it does not.

Phipps asks if the jewelry will be manufactured on site.

Applicant states that she designs the jewelry and has its produced overseas and she then will ship it from the location proposed.

Discussion about what the best way to move forward without holding the applicant up takes place.

Kienz states that he can draft a resolution for the next meeting so if the board acts favorable it can be voted on that night. He also feels the applicant should include lot 27 and 26.
