OLD BUSINESS / NEW BUSINESS

Sparta Bowling Lanes

Sam spoke to Tom at Sparta Lanes and set up the bowling event for Sunday, March 22 from 2 pm – 4 pm. This year Sparta Lanes will be charging for the rental for shoes - \$4.50 plus the \$9.00 to bowl the 2 games. Members discuss contacting Warwick Lanes but decide to do so for next year. Instead they decide to charge a pre-registration fee of \$10.00 – paid by March 20th or the full amount of \$13.50 on the day of the event. Recreation will cover the difference. Flyers will be sent to the school.

Family Fun Night

Members discuss two available dates to swim at the YMCA and decide on April 4th from 5:45 pm – 7:45 pm. The cost will be \$225.00 for the two hours for up to 25 people in the pool and then an additional \$25.00 as more lifeguards will be necessary. The YMCA will provide snacks and drinks at an additional cost to recreation. Flyers will be sent to the school.

Ice cream social

Members look at Sunday, June 28th from 2 pm – 4 pm to hold the event but also mentioning this will depend on music being provided by Tom Gardner and his schedule. Kathy will email Tom to find out his availability and cost.

Hamburg Contests

A June 14th date is agreed upon as long as it is available with the Hamburg School. Set up will be at 12 noon with the contests starting at 1 pm.

Miners Baseball Game

A July 18th date is decided on, with Hamburg throwing out the 1st pitch and singing the National Anthem. This is a firework night and tickets were requested behind home plate again. Recreation will purchase 76 tickets at \$9.00 for a total of \$684.00. Tickets will be purchased at townhall before the event date. Kathy will submit the purchase order and contact the stadium for the tickets and Sam will pick them up.

Hamburg Day
