AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 203 - VEHICLES & TRAFFIC - OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMBURG TO RESTRICT THE USE OF CERTAIN PARKING SPACES TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE PERSONNEL, BOROUGH EMPLOYEES AND OTHER DESIGNATED PERSONS.

## Ordinance # 14 - 2011

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hamburg, in the County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 203 - VEHICLES & TRAFFIC - of the Code of the Borough of Hamburg is hereby amended as follows

## 1. New Sections

203.24 - <u>Reserved Parking</u> on Block 5, Lots 6, 6X and 7 as shown on the Hamburg Tax Map.

No person shall park a vehicle on Block 5, Lots 6, 6X and 7 where the parking space is designated for parking for Emergency Service personnel, borough employees and other designated personnel as may be determined from time to time by resolution of the Mayor and Council.

- 2. If any of this Ordinance is deemed or declared invalid for whatsoever reason by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
  - 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
